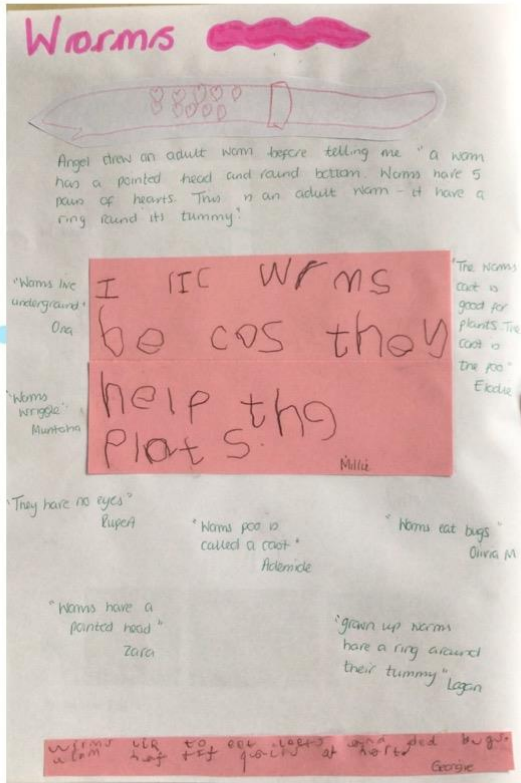


There were misconceptions to address and introductions to minibeasts to be had.

Worms



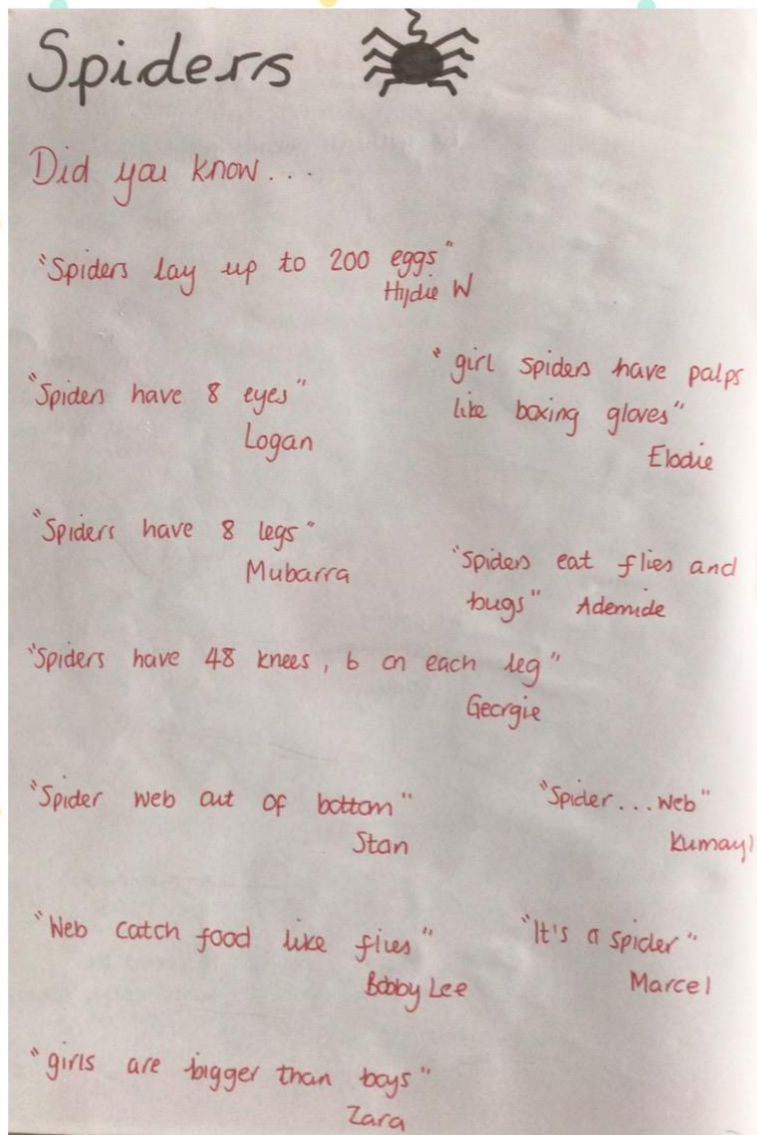
We read Yucky Worms learning lots of facts about worms.

We created a class wormery.



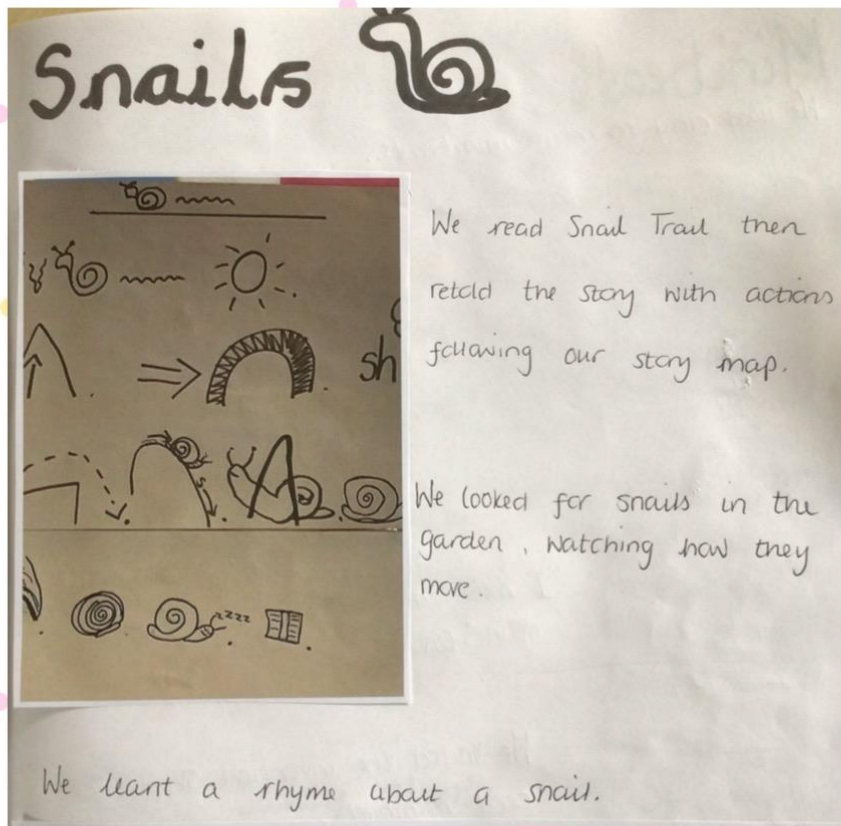
Spiders

Snails

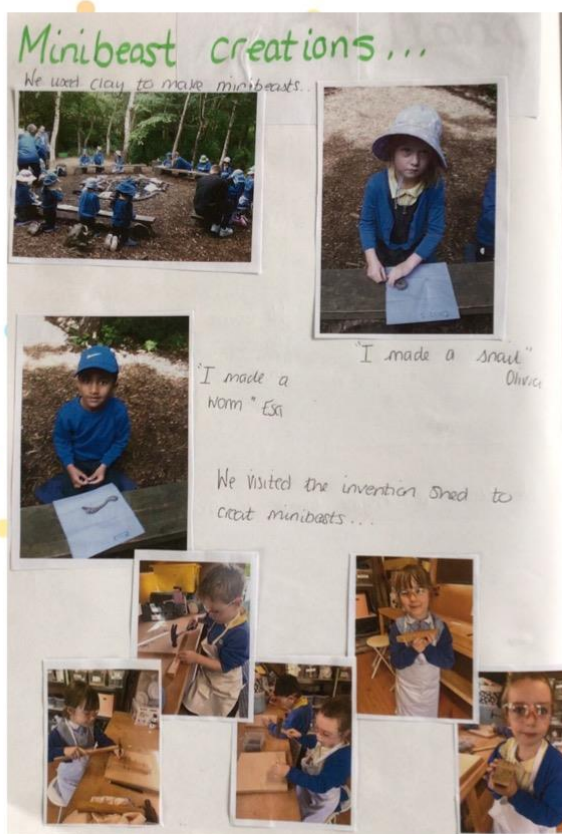


We enjoyed exploring the snails in our garden, watching them move and investigate their surroundings.

We visited Scotswood nature gardens. We enjoyed learning about minibeasts before looking for them in their habitats.

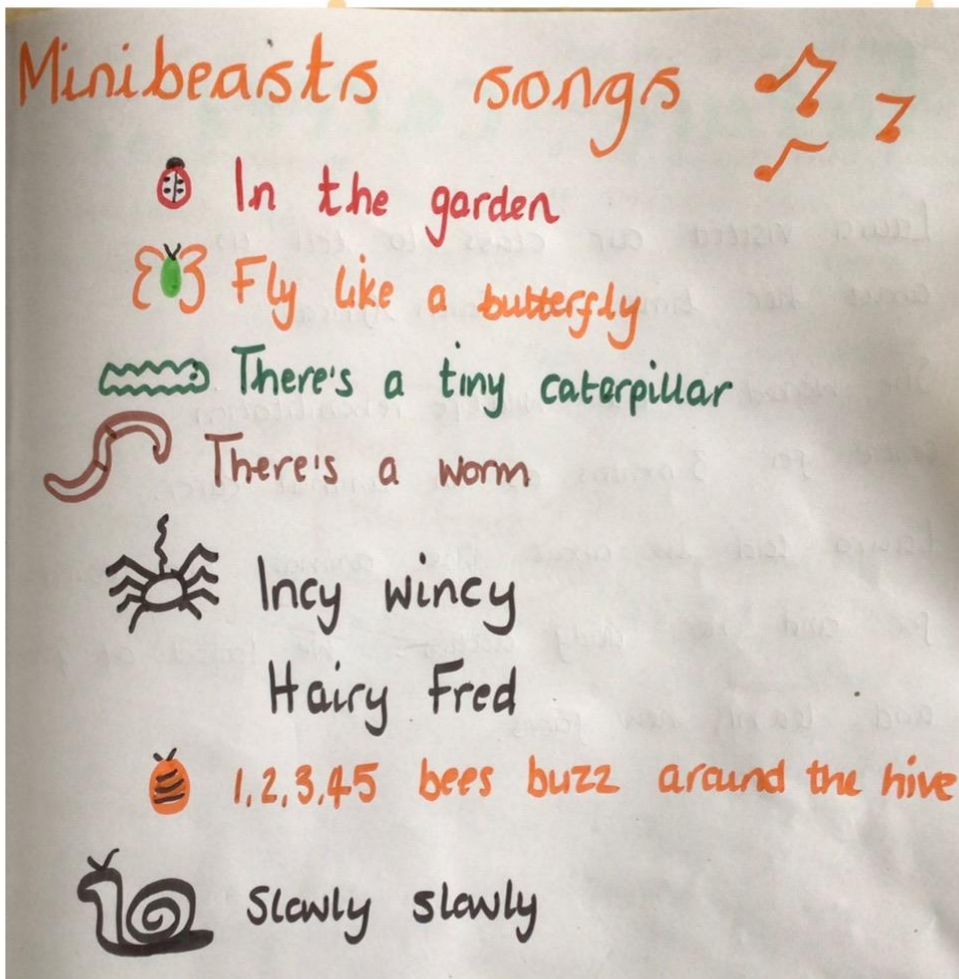
We made clay minibeasts

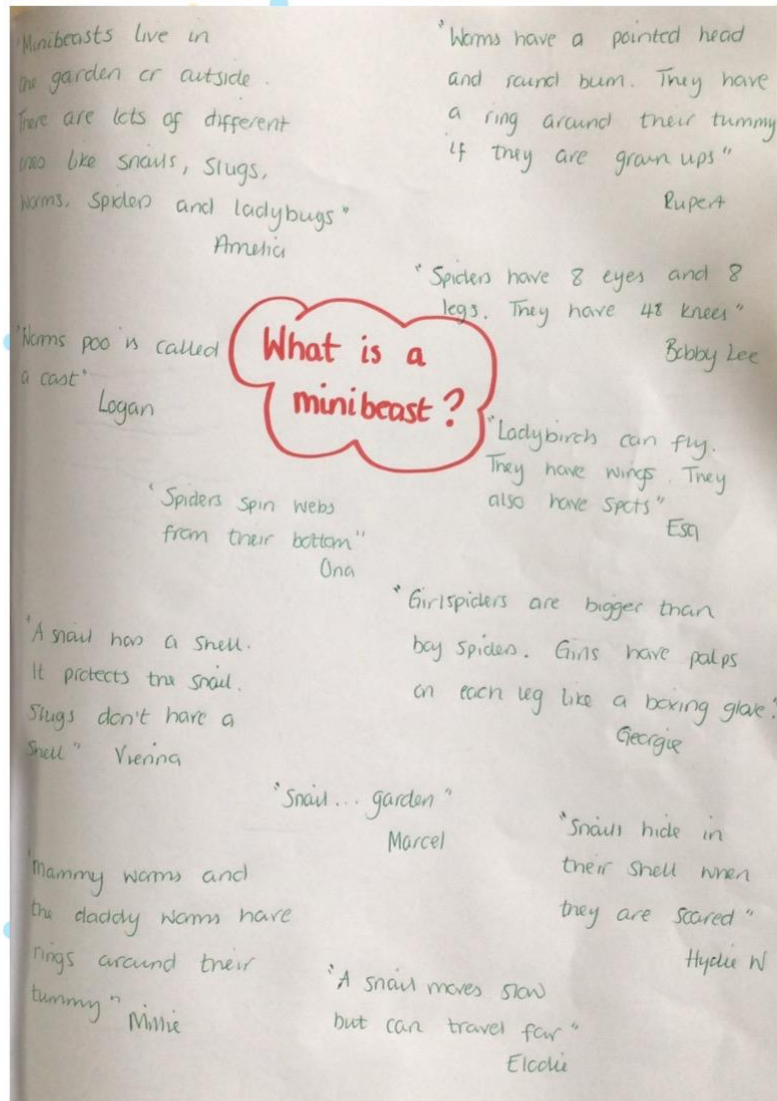
Future career opportunities
