EYFS History	History: In Nursery & Reception, children begin to form the foundations for later work in history. Children have lots of opportunities to develop a sense of past and present, through lots of discussion. Children are encouraged to talk about their experiences of events, for example, Christmas and birthdays, using the language 'yesterday', 'today', 'last week'. Children also examine appropriate artefacts (for example: Boxes of delights or household artefacts) or discovering the meaning of old and new in relation to their own lives.
