Parents must try to continue to not just turn up at the office without an appointment. If you need anything you can email or ring and if an appointment is needed a time will be given to you. Please do not be offended if you are politely turned away from the office if you turn up without an appointment at busy times. This is to avoid a large gathering of people. Teachers will be available for a quick chat at the end of the day but longer conversations need an appointment booked.
