

Year 4 Multiplication Tables Check (MTC) Results 2024

- ✚ The purpose of the MTC check is to determine whether your child can fluently recall their times tables up to 12 x 12, which is essential for future success in mathematics. It will also help to identify if your child may need additional support.
- ✚ It is an on-screen check consisting of 25 times table questions. Your child will be able to answer 3 practice questions before taking the actual check. They will then have 6 seconds to answer each question. On average, the check should take no longer than 5 minutes to complete.
- ✚ There are several access arrangements available for the check, which can be used to support pupils with specific needs. Your child's teacher will ensure that the access arrangements are appropriate for your child before they take the check in June.
- ✚ The check has been designed to be inclusive and accessible to as many children as possible, including those with special educational needs or disability (SEND) or English as an additional language (EAL). However, there may be some circumstances in which it will not be appropriate for a pupil to take the check, even when using suitable access arrangements.
- ✚ The test was administered between Monday 3rd June and Friday 21st June 2024. At Bridgewater the test was administered over this three week time frame.
- ✚ There is no pass mark for the MTC.
- ✚ At Bridgewater, we use a range of strategies for teaching times tables. We count in multiples, we say times tables, we play times table games. We access TTRockstars both at home and in school. Other Apps include White Rose 1 minute maths and www.timestables.co.uk. We also encourage and play a range of times table games within Breakfast Club and at other times throughout the school day.

Cohort profile

This was a cohort of 59 children who were registered across two classes.

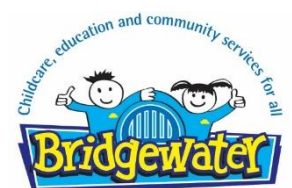
There are 30 boys and 29 girls.
