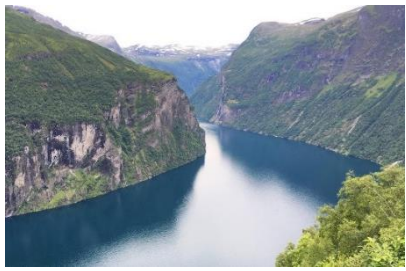


Norway

Glaciers are huge, thick masses of ice which form when lots of snow falls in one place over many years



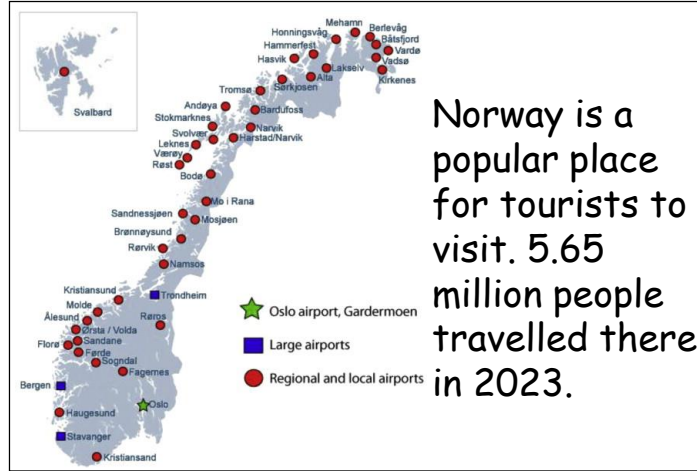
The capital city of Norway is Oslo.



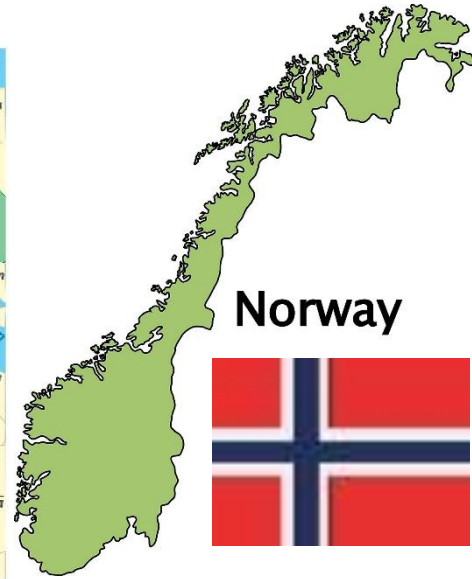
Galdhøpiggen is the highest mountain at 2469m.
