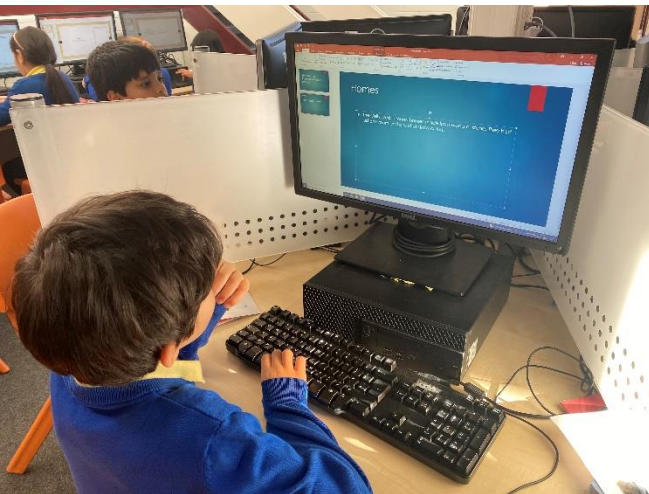


What is the significance of the Roman Invasion of Britain?
